Particularly, the subject land is not identified in any Council or State Government endorsed strategy as potential or future employment land, including in the Illawarra Shoalhaven Regional Plan, the recently adopted Shellharbour Local Strategic Planning Statement or the Shellharbour Employment Lands Study. Further, the site is located at the end of the main runway of the Shellharbour Airport, and Council has identified the airport as a critical piece of infrastructure for the region, and increasing development potential in this area presents an increased risk to achieving Council's strategic objectives in relation to the airport.
