2023/24 Sustainability Rebates Program

In 2023/24, round 1 of Council's Small Environmental Projects Fund (SEPF) provided the following rebates to eligible homeowners and landlords for the installation of sustainability products as part of the Sustainability Rebates Program.







Induction cooktop 10% up to \$250



Electric vehicle chargers 10% up to \$250




Home battery 5% up to \$500

The aim of the program was to support the community to move toward electrification and energy efficient appliances powered by solar energy to achieve our goal of net zero community emissions by 2050.

Applications for Round 1 of the program have now closed.

In total 60 rebates totalling approximately \$25,000 were provided to the community in round 1. The graph below shows uptake in terms of the number of rebates accessed across the rebate categories.



Feedback from participants indicated 95% of applicants would recommend the rebate program to other residents should future rounds become available.
