

Putting the brakes on illegal trail bike activity

In NSW, it is illegal to ride an unregistered motorcycle on sealed/unsealed roads, footpaths, reserves and sports fields. You may only ride on private land with the owner's permission, or at a designated track.

Riding unregistered motorcycles or being an unlicensed rider poses an extreme safety risk to the community, the rider and their passengers. Riding in reserves, parklands, playgrounds and sports fields is also dangerous and destructive to our community spaces.

Please do NOT report illegal trail bike activity to Council or Police via social media sites
