- The signage on the ladies toilet at Warilla Library indicates that it contains a change table but there is not one there.
- A member raised that there is no specialised disability accommodation in Shellharbour other than group homes.
- The temporary toilet block at Reddall Reserve has no accessible facilities the Committee would like to see portable accessible facilities provided along with the other portable facilities.
- A letter has been received from Anna Watson's Office, Member for Shellharbour, on behalf of residents regarding the lack of a kerb ramp on Wallaroo Drive, Blackbutt. The Assets team are currently working with the Transport team to identify potential solutions.
- The locked toilet facilities in Oak Flats have been linked to recent power outages, which changes the timers and the facilities don't unlock at the correct time. Residents are asked to advise Council if this occurs again.
