Council is proposing to enter into a new licence for the Hire of Lanes and occupation of the Clubhouse located on Council owned Community Land for the occupation of Part Lot 1 DP 224750, Hope Street, Oak Flats Oak Flats Swimming Pool for a 3 year term.

The licenced area will be used for the purpose of the hiring of swimming pool lanes and occupation of the clubhouse.

Council is required to advertise this proposal under Section 47A of the *Local Government Act 1993* for a period of twenty-eight (28) days.

At the end of the submission period, Council will formally consider whether to enter into a new licence agreement.
