The purpose of this memo is to consider a road naming proposal.

Council resolution number 169 on 19 November 2013 resolved:

That Council give delegation to the General Manager to approve and authorise Road Names which comply with the adopted Policy as amended from time to time.

The following road name has been submitted to Council for consideration:

Applicant: Site Plus Pty Ltd
Proposed Name: Sanctuary Circuit
Suburb/Location: Lot 574 DP1280625 at Tomerong Street Tullimbar as part of DA0630/2022 and DAM0119/2025

The name follows the theme adopted for Tullimbar and is based on towns, villages and place names of the Illawarra and South Coast of NSW. Sanctuary Point is a South Coast town on the shores of St Georges Basin.

The applicant is proposing to utilise a name approved for Tullimbar on 13 December 2005 for DA741/2002. The name has not been advertised or gazetted.

The proposed road name complies with Council's adopted Policy Naming and Addressing (Roads, Public Reserves, Parks, Sportsfields, Assets)– POL-0108.

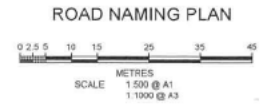
