Council wants to make sure people with a disability are included.

Definitions

Access:

is the ability for everyone
to use or enter something

Inclusion:

is the ability for everyone
to join an activity

Why we need a plan



Lots of people with a disability live and work in Shellharbour.

People with a disability often have less education than other people.

More people with a disability are unemployed than people without a disability.

Australia has laws that say we need to do better at including people with a disability in schools, work and all parts of the community.

Council wants to improve opportunities for everyone in the community.

How we made this plan



We talked to

- People with disabilities
- Their families and friends
- Staff at Council



We asked people to tell us what stops them from being included in their community.



We talked to people in different ways

- We asked people to fill in surveys
- We held meetings
- We talked to people over the phone
- We used social media e.g. Facebook

What we need to do

You told us what we need to do.



Talk to people with a disability about what matters to them.

Make sure all areas and events are easy to use for everyone.

Make access to beaches, parks, toilets, playgrounds and buildings better for everyone.

Have more jobs for people with a disability.



Make sure everyone can understand things by making information easy to read, using Auslan and in other ways.

- 3. Employment**
- 4. Making systems better**

This plan talks about what Council will do to make access and inclusion better for people with a disability.

Attitudes



People in our community are all different.



We want people with a disability to feel welcome and be part of the community.



People with a disability must be able to go to events and use all services.



People with a disability must feel safe in their community.

How we will do this



We will

Give people information about events that include everyone.



Use respectful words and photos of people with a disability.



Work with local companies to make sure they are accessible and include people with a disability.



Ask people with a disability what they need and want.

Making your community accessible



We want everyone to be able to live, work and play in Shellharbour.

We want places in the community that are easier to use.

We need

- More accessible public toilets including toilets for people who need a hoist
- Better paths and carparks
- More accessible pools, parks, playgrounds and beaches
- Better access to bus stops, train stations and the airport

How we will do this



We will

Make access to beaches, lakes and pools easier.



Make sure new parks have accessible paths and equipment including toilets and change areas.



Make sure bus stops are easier to access.



Ask for better access to public transport and more affordable housing in our area.

Employment



People with a disability can work at Council and in local businesses.

We need

- Flexible work hours to make it easier to have a job.
- Changes to the work place to make it accessible for everyone.
- To let people volunteer or do work experience to learn more about jobs they like.

How we will do this



We will

Make sure applying for jobs is easy for everyone.



Make sure staff are trained in respecting people with disability.



Let other businesses know that employing people with disability is good for everyone.

Making systems better



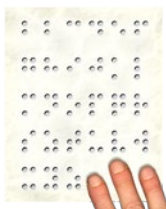
Council systems and practices need to be easy to use.



Council must be easy to contact by phone, email, letter or in person.



Information must be easy to read and understand.



Some signs need to be in Braille for examples bus stops, toilets and Council buildings.



Everyone must be welcome to Council meetings.



People must have free internet access at Council sites, for example, at the libraries.

How we will do this



We will

Make sure all information is easy to read and understand.



Make the Council website easy to use for everyone.



Make sure people can use the National Relay Service or interpreter services if they need to.



Have easy ways for people to give feedback and make complaints.

Where to from here?



- Council will work with other businesses to make access and inclusion better for everyone.
- Council will look at funding to build new things like fishing platforms and change rooms.
- Council will talk to people with a disability about how well the changes are working.
- Council will send a report to the community every year.
- Council will send a report to the NSW Minister for Disability Services every year.
- Council will do a full review in 2026.
